Changes to the Event Structure for The Pokémon Championships 2022-23 Singapore Video Game Category

In order to offer a consistent Championships experience across all Asia regions, we have decided to update the event structure and competition format for the Pokémon Championships 2022-23 Singapore Video Game Category, initially planned on Sunday, May 21, 2023.

We do realize that this change comes just before the start of the entry period for the event, and sincerely apologize for the inconvenience this may cause for some players.

Note that the changes to the event structure do not affect the conditions or number of invites to be given for the Pokémon World Championships 2023 in Yokohama, which remain the same as before: the 1st Place player in the final rankings will get a Day 2 invite, while the 2nd, 3rd and 4th Place players will get a Day 1 invite.
